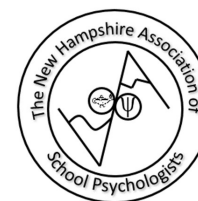

Autism Conversations

A Framework for Assessment and Intervention Across Age and Ability Levels

Learning Objectives

At the conclusion of this program, participants will be able to:

- Over the course of this workshop, participants will:
1. Use a visual organizational framework in line with the DSM-5 and IDEA criteria to recognize the full range of autism spectrum differences in school-aged students (preschool through secondary).
 2. Use descriptive language in explaining autism spectrum differences to parents and teachers.
 3. Be able to list 2 key tools to conduct a sensory-based diagnostic interview with students whose communication skills range from verbally fluent to functionally nonverbal.
 4. Recognize a range of autism spectrum evaluation tools and identify how to use a core group of tools to make effective diagnostic determinations.
 5. Develop individualized Brain Style Profiles across age and ability levels.
 6. Identify the four key narrative shifts that individuals, parents, and teachers need to make in order to move towards positive independent adult functioning.
 7. Identify key supports and interventions that link to the key narrative shifts.
 8. Identify the three interview components that comprise the MIGDAS-2 process and their role in a core group of autism assessment tools.

Conference Description

This intermediate level presentation is appropriate for school psychologists, SAIFF's, educational evaluators, speech-language pathologists, special education directors, and other educators who work with students at any level.

This one-day conference provides a practical framework to understand and talk about autism spectrum brain style differences in students across age and ability levels. Participants will be introduced to qualitative interview techniques using the MIGDAS-2 evaluation process, and learn to develop individualized behavioral profiles highlighting student strengths and differences. Participants will gain practical skills in identifying and implementing key educational supports and interventions to address organizational, regulation, and self-determination skills development in an individualized way.
